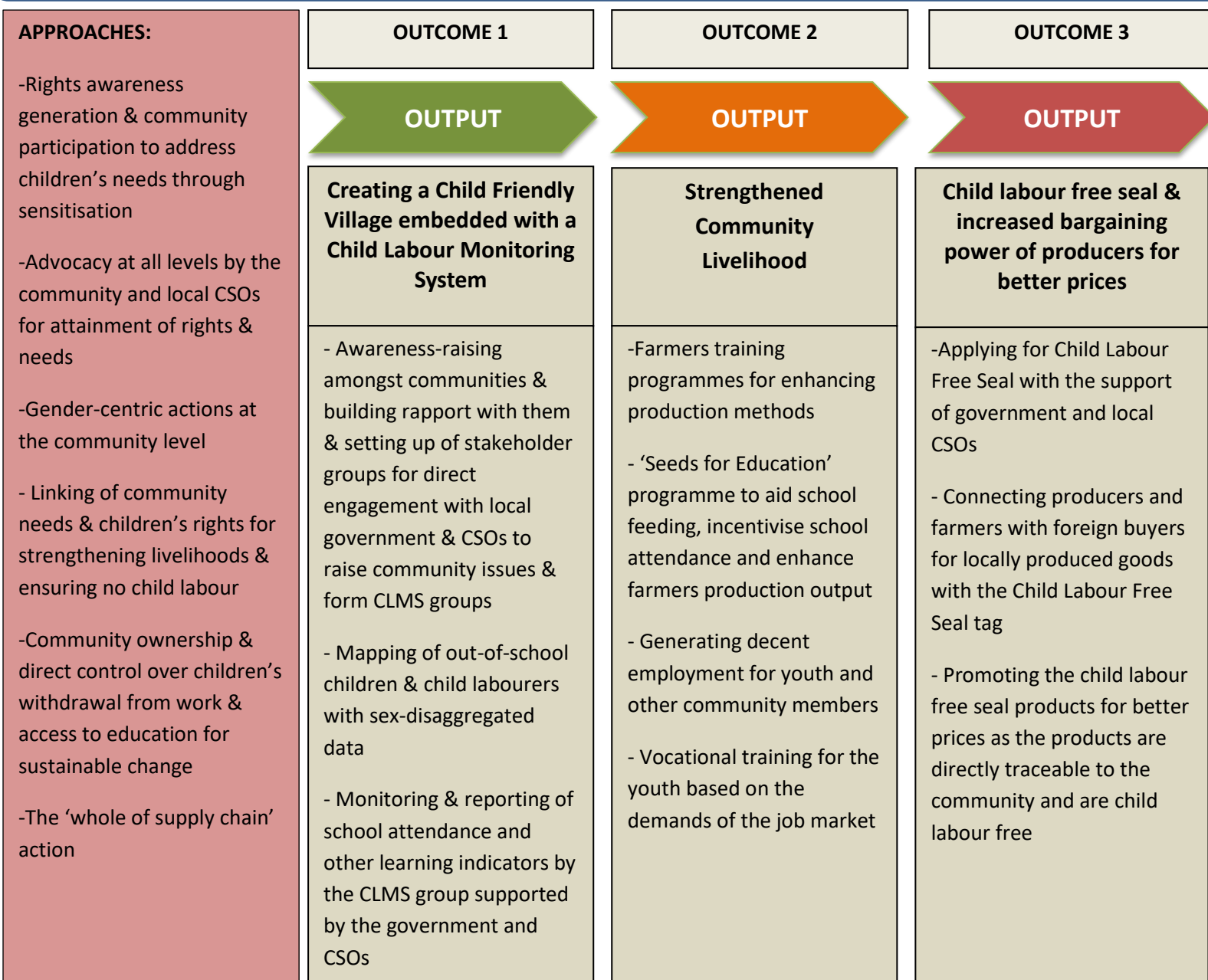


Theory of Change – Addressing Child Labour in Supply Chains

LONG TERM IMPACTS
