## If we eliminate these barriers and send girls to schools, she can:



Break the cycle of poverty
When women and girls earn, they reinvest $90 \%$ into their families and are able to eliminate generational child labour and send their children to school.


Keep her family healthy When more girls are educated, they are likely to immunise their children and the rates of HIV and malnutrition are likely to decline.

Increase the GDP of her country
When $10 \%$ more girls go to school, a country's GDP increases an average of $3 \%$
