WHO WE ARE

Founded by Nobel Peace Laureate, Kailash Satyarthi, Global March Against Child Labour is a global movement of trade unions, teachers unions and other organisations from over 100 countries committed to make a world free of child labour, promote quality education and advocate for elimination of economic exploitation of all children in the world.

Some of the major achievements of Global March are:

- Inclusion of the term 'slavery' in the SDGs through our advocacy
- Organisation of 80,000 km physical march across the globe with 7 million people speaking against child labour which led to the formation of ILO Convention No. 182 on Worst Forms of Child Labour - the fastest ratified Convention in the history of ILO
- Founding of a strong global movement to end child labour
- Mobilisation of more than 100 MPs through the Parliamentarians Without Borders for Children's Rights initiative
- Putting focus on gender responsive interventions to end child labour at global, regional and national platforms
- Representing global civil society voice at the Alliance 8.7 platform to achieve SDG Target 8.7
- Leading successful campaigns on child rights issues including Child Labour in Domestic Work, Child Slavery, Child Labour in Business Supply Chains, Out of School Children
